

REGULATIONS FOR EUROPEAN ROBOT CHALLENGE OPOLE 2017

EUROPEAN ROBOT CHALLENGE OPOLE 2017

§ 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. The present Regulations define the principles for the organisation of European Robot Challenge Opole 2017, valid for European Robot Challenge Opole 2017 Users.
2. Any reference in these Regulations made to:
 - a) Regulations – shall apply to European Robot Challenge Opole 2017 Regulations;
 - b) Event – shall apply to European Robot Challenge Opole 2017;
 - c) GROM – shall apply to Grupa Robotycznie Opętanych Maniaków (the Group of Robotically Possessed Maniacs);
 - d) PNT – shall apply to Park Naukowo Technologiczny in Opole (Opole Science and Technology Park);
 - e) PO – shall apply to Politechnika Opolska (Opole University of Technology);
 - f) UM – shall apply to Urząd Miasta Opola (Opole City Hall);
 - g) CWK – shall apply to Centrum Wystawienniczo-Kongresowe in Opole (Exhibition and Congress Centre in Opole);
 - h) Organizer – shall apply to Opole City Hall, which is the main operational event organiser;
 - i) Co-organizer – shall apply to GROM, PNT and PO, substantive and financial Co-organizers of the Event;
 - j) User – an entity participating in the Event;
 - k) Sponsor – shall apply to a company or legal person, hereinafter a User, that concluded a contract with the organizers to financially support the Event in exchange for the advertisement and in accordance with the sponsorship package;
 - l) Exhibitor – shall apply to the Sponsor, who has purchased the sponsorship package providing the exhibition space;
 - m) Participant – a registered and verified Event User, making use of the services intended for the Participants;
 - n) Visitor – an unregistered Event User (people visiting the Event site);
 - o) Exhibition area – shall apply to exhibition stands set out in the sponsorship package, ordered by the Sponsors;

- p) Registration form – a form completed by the User during the registration process;
 - q) Competition – competitions described in paragraph 6 of this Regulation;
3. The exhibitors ordering the exhibition space shall comply with: ‘Regulations for the participants of the fair exhibition organized by the Exhibition and Congress Centre in Opole’, available on www.erc.po.opole.pl :
- a) Provisions listed in paragraph 4 of the ‘Regulations for the participants of the fair exhibition organized by the Exhibition and Congress Centre in Opole’ do not apply to the Exhibitors participating in the Event;
 - b) CWK (Exhibition and Congress Centre in Opole) is party to the Exhibitor in relation to all activities (such as complaints, rules for the stand assembly and dismantling , etc.).
4. Event User is obliged to comply with the technical regulations, fire safety regulations, and OHS regulations in force on the grounds of the Exhibition and Congress Centre in Opole, listed in Annex 1 and 2 to these regulations.

§ 2. EVENT DATE AND VENUE

- 1. Date: 13 May 2017
- 2. Venue: Exhibition and Congress Centre in Opole, ul. Wrocławska 158, 45-835 Opole

§ 3. EVENT PARTICIPATION – PARTICIPANT

- 1. Any User validly registered on www.erc.po.opole.pl website is an Event Participant.
- 2. Participants registration will be possible from 21 March 2017 to 6 May 2017.
- 3. The registration process entails the following steps:
 - a) On-line registration on www.erc.po.opole.pl website with the data properly entered into the appropriate sections of the registration form;
 - b) Participant’s acceptance of the conditions of participation in the Event, consent to the personal data processing and the acceptance of the Event and CWK Regulations in order to change the service status to ‘registered’;
 - c) The Participant receives a registration certificate for the purpose of confirmation sent to the participant’s e-mail address indicated in the registration form;
 - d) Granting the ‘verified’ status to the registered Participant at the registration desk in order to confirm the arrival at the location of the Event.
- 4. The Participant shall assume full responsibility for the accuracy of the data provided while entering the Event, and when completing the registration form the Participant submits a written statement on the veracity of the data provided during registration.

5. Only the Participants recognized as 'verified' can be admitted to the Competition.
6. The participation in the Event and the Competition is free of charge.

§ 4 PARTICIPATION IN THE EVENT - EXHIBITORS

1. In order to participate in the Event the following terms are bound to be fulfilled:
 - a) The Sponsor selects a Sponsorship Package: Silver or Gold.
 - b) The Sponsor signs the financial support agreement with the organizers in exchange for publicity.
 - c) The Sponsor pays full agreed charge.

§ 5 PARTICIPATION IN THE EVENT – VISITORS

1. Visiting the Event is free of charge and does not require registration.

§ 6 COMPETITION

1. Competition in particular categories will be held according to the schedule available at www.erc.po.opole.pl
2. Detailed schedule will be published 7 days before the Event.
3. The Organizer retains the right to change the schedule.
4. The following are the planned Competition categories:
 - a. LineFollower
 - b. LineFollower Drag
 - c. LineFollower Enhanced
 - d. Pico Sumo
 - e. Nano Sumo
 - f. Micro Sumo
 - g. Mini Sumo
 - h. Sumo
 - i. Mega Sumo
 - j. Humanoid Sumo
 - k. Humanoid Sprint
 - l. Micro Mouse
 - m. Free Style
 - n. Air Race
 - o. Lego Sumo
 - p. Lego LineFollower
5. Regulations concerning the particular events are in the attachment 3 – 8 hereof.
6. The Organizer retains the right to cancel an event in case there are fewer than ten Competitors.

7. The Competitors will be informed of the above seven days before the Competition in case of incomplete list of the online enrollments, or on the Event day in case there are fewer competitors than required.

8. Winners of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd positions will be awarded with a tangible prize.

§ 7 PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION

1. It is P.O. based at ul. Prószkowska 76, Opole, Poland that is responsible for administering the personal data.

2. On registering as an Event Participant the User acknowledges and accepts that their personal data can be used for the Event realization purposes.

3. The personal data stored in the P.O.'s database are processed only for the Event realization purpose. The data are gathered, thoroughly stored and protected from unauthorized access in accordance with the law on personal data protection (O.J. 1997 no 133, item 883) and with the law on providing on-line services (O.J. 2002 no 144, item 1204). The User is entitled to have access to their own data to make corrections or to demand to cease making use of them any time they will.

4. The Users' personal data can be made accessible to the competent authorities if required, by the binding legal regulations.

§ 8. OPENING DAYS AND HOURS FOR EXHIBITORS ACCOMPANYING THE EVENT

1. The Organizer sets the following days and hours for opening the venue for Exhibitors throughout the Event:
 - a) with the purpose of installation and arrangement of stands along with equipment thereof: 12 May, 2017, times: 8.00 to 16.00;
 - b) for the duration of the Event: 13 May, 2017 r, times: 8.00 to 18:00.
 - c) with the purpose of dismantling the stands: 13 May 2016 r, times: 18.00 to 24.00.

2. During the event the stands shall be available to Visitors. The possibility of temporary closing of a stand during the Event, its earlier dismantling or earlier removal of exhibits from the stand is not permitted without gaining prior consent of the Organizer.

§ 9. ADMISSION PRINCIPLES TO AREA OF EXHIBITION AND CONGRESS CENTRE IN OPOLE (CWK)

1. Exhibitors – ID badges for EXHIBITORS are issued by the organizer and give the right of admission to the exhibition hall in the CWK and VIP zones during the assembly, arrangement and dismantling of the Exhibitor's stand as well as for the duration of the Event.
2. Participants – ID badges for PARTICIPANTS are issued by the organizer and give the right of admission to the exhibition hall in the CWK and VIP zones for the duration of the Event
3. ID badges are issued at the organizer's office located in the CWK premises.
4. Visitors are admitted at no entry fee and are not provided with an ID badge for the entry to the venue at CWK premises for the duration of the event.

§ 10. SAFETY

1. The Users of the Event and the other persons within the area of the Event are obliged to behave in a manner that does not compromise the safety of other persons present at the Event. In particular, all participants are required to respect and follow the provisions of these Regulations and other events organized by the Exhibition and Congress Center in Opole and the Technical Regulations for Fire Protection And Safety in the area of the Exhibition And Congress Centre in Opole (Available at www.cwkopole.pl).
2. The Organizer reserves the right to refuse entry to the Event:
 - a. anyone under the visible influence of alcohol, narcotic drugs, psychotropic drugs or other similarly active agents,
 - b. anyone in hold of alcoholic beverage,
 - c. anyone in possession of a weapon or other dangerous objects, explosives, pyrotechnic articles, fire-fighting materials, drugs or psychotropic substances.
 - d. anyone behaving aggressively, provocatively or otherwise posing a threat to public security or order.
3. Evaluation and classification of objects as undesirable belongs to the security and technical and information services.
4. The security and technical and information services are entitled to:
 - a. issue orders to individuals breaking the public peace or behaving against the provision of the Regulations and in the event when such commands are not followed – to require them to leave the area of the Event
 - b. use physical force in the form of incapacitating holds and similar defense techniques in case of a danger to the entrusted goods or to respond to an attack on a member of security and technical and information services or another person, in accordance with

rules defined in article 38 of August 22nd, 1997 in Persons and Property Protection Act (O.J.,1997, issue 114, entry 740 with amendments)

- c. detain anyone who directly creates a threat to human life and health as well as to the property secured, in order to immediately transfer the persons to the Police.
5. The security and technical and information services are obliged to remove from the Event Site anyone who, by their behavior, disrupt public order or behave in a manner inconsistent with the Regulations stated herein.
6. Organizer is not responsible for the effects of force majeure. Force majeure under the scope of this regulation refers to any unforeseeable situation or event of exceptional character beyond the control of the parties, preventing any one of its obligations, and in particular, natural disaster events in floods, hurricanes, or extraordinary and external events that could not be prevented (war, restrictions of martial law, uprisings, revolutions, riots, protesters against town enlargement etc.).

§ 11. FINAL PROVISIONS

1. In case the Event date or location is changed or it is cancelled, The Organizer will immediately inform of this fact by sending an email.
2. The Participants declare and acknowledge that they know and accept the contents of the Regulation for the Event.
3. The Participants hereby expressly authorize the Organizer to process their personal data provided to the Organizer during the registration process.
4. The Organizers reserve the right to record the course of Event using image and sound recording equipment. Participation in the Event is synonymous with granting the Organizer the right to take photographs and video recordings of the Participants along with the transmission and distribution of voice or image records for documentation, reports, advertising and promotion activities in connection with any program or publication in which the record of the Event will be used.
5. Throughout the Event, the Participants and any other persons staying in its venue are obliged to follow the provisions of Education in Sobriety and Alcoholism Prevention Act as of 26 October 1982.
6. In the matters not stipulated under this Regulation, provisions of the Polish Civil Code shall be applicable, as of 23 April 1964 (O.J. 1964, no. 16, item 93 with further amendments).
7. These Regulations are also available on the Organizer's website: www.cwkopole.pl, at the Event website www.erc.po.opole.pl and in the Organizer's office.
8. These Regulations enter into force on 20 March, 2017.
